Thank you for your interest regarding becoming a Gouling SleepTalk consultant. Applicants with the professional background such as your self are indeed very welcome to the team, however please be advised that acceptance into the Gouling SleepTalk™ for Children Consultancy training program is not limited on the basis of age, gender, social or educational background, however qualifications and experience in an appropriate field of the 'helping professions', e.g., Clinical Hypnotherapy, Health Care, Communication, Psychology, Education, Human Resources, Naturopathy, or Counselling would be an advantage. The nature and depth of applicants' formal qualifications will vary widely, but participants must be of mature age with a demonstrated desire to learn the techniques and strategies offered.

Each applicant needs to have an ability to cope with the academic and practical requirements of the course, and be motivated with a desire to assist parents to implement the program. In addition, a sound level of emotional maturity and life experience will assist in empathising with, and appropriately responding to clients' needs.

Importantly, applicants are required to make a commitment to applying the highest ethical standards in their work with the Gouling SleepTalk™ program. To ensure the absolute integrity of the program, a police report will be required, even though the Gouling SleepTalk™ process does not require the Consultant to work directly with children.

The training offered is over 3 practical (1day) training sessions within a 4 month time frame. A minimum 24 hours of practical training is required which offers up to 100 nominal hours for assignments and case histories requirements. Competency is assessed throughout the course and includes workshop participation and written project-based case history documentation. Recognition for prior learning is acknowledged in the fee structure upon application. 'Fast Track' training is also available for interstate or off shore participants.

Certification that the participant has attained the required levels of competency allows the graduate to apply basic and advanced strategies and techniques. Graduate Consultant's certification allows the holder of that award to establish their own Gouling SleepTalk™ practice and will be registered on the SleepTalk Support and the Smart Parenting website. www.smart-parenting.com
